"Le Barachois" is situated in the charming and historical area of Vieux Grand Port at Anse Bambous in the south east of the island. The stonework of its rustic buildings blending in beautifully with the timber and thatch of its roof, "Le Barachois" offers not only pleasure for your stomach, but for all your other senses too.

Relaxed and unstressed, you will make a choice of live oysters, crabs and lobster etc, and in the restaurant, it will be delicately prepared for your pleasure. All of the homegrown products are prepared for you "à la Mauricienne" meaning with lots of tender loving care.

The reserve encircled by a mangrove forest is the home of a multitude of sea creatures and all types of fish, but can also be your home while you are in Mauritius. A track meanders through the mangrove forest allowing you to discover first hand the secrets of this natural incubator. And after your long discovery tour, you may be happy to rest in your comfortably rustic room or sit on your veranda and enjoy the sea or Mountain View.

Tucked between the sky, the mountains and the sea, the place is a veritable historic treasure chest, as the famous battle of Vieux Grand Port took place nearby in 1810. Silence and peace will engulf you while you are breathing in the fresh air, which has caressed the unpolluted shores of Antarctica before traveling over the South Seas.
