## FACILITIES



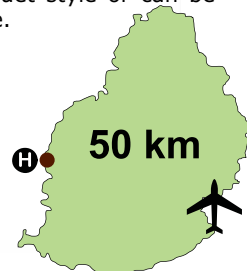
